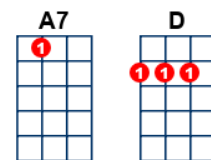


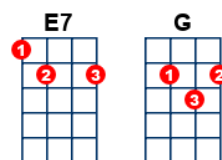
# I'd Like To Teach The World To Sing 2019-11-14
