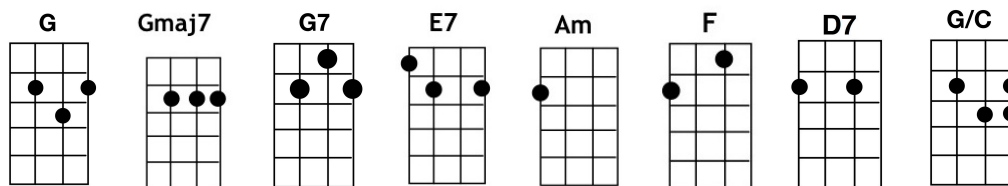


We're All Home Bound
