Use Masking tape over holes 1&2 and 7,8,9 & 10

[C] Here I [G] stand [Bb] head in [C] hand

[F] Turn my face to the [Bb] wall [F]

Use Masking tape over holes 1&2 and 7,8,9 & 10

[G] Here I [D] stand [F] head in [G] hand

g g a c c b-a-g

[C] Turn my face to the [F] wall [C]

Easy Harmonica Secrets

Lick lips often

- I wish someone told me these things 50 years ago.

1 To begin, use masking tape to cover holes not used, - avoid songs with notes below hole 3, or above 7
-- for the above songs use masking tape over holes 1&2 and 7 through 10. It's Easy now with only 4 holes to play !

2 Play "loose" - blow or draw 3 holes (chords) at a time - so where it shows "+4" exhale holes 3,4 & 5, for "-5" inhale holes 4, 5 & 6

2 Other good "Chord" song examples are by Bob Dylan and Billy Joel, - using a harmonica holder (the \$12.50 by Stageline)

3 Practice in private - a harp can annoy other people - it's for your personal enjoyment, *carry it with you*

4 Practicing 10 minutes every day is better than an hour once a week

Most popular Harmonica Keys are C, G & D

5 Hear the song (words) in your head - then *play like you were just whistling*

Also see YouTube for helpful tips.

6 Practice the first lines slowly, then speed up - repeating first lines over and over.

Now enjoy another musical voice !

7 After a few years, then you can start to call yourself a beginner, playing single notes and "bending" becomes easier
